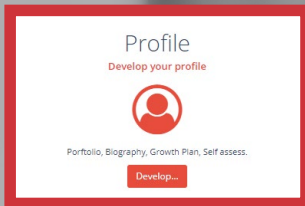

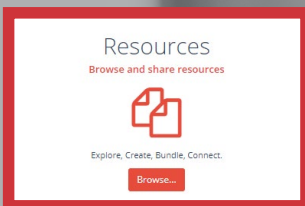

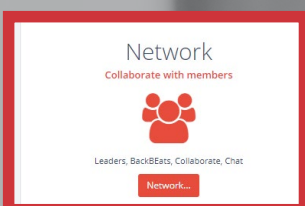




Create a personal profile with your biography, photo and experience
